MESSAGE "Sharing Your Life Message" Rev. Yohan Baek

SERMON NOTES:

Note 1: A top priority in our church is BRINGING PEOPLE TO JESUS!

Note 2: We humans were not made to be independent of each other. We were made to be interdependent.

Note 3: 1 Peter 3:8

"You should be like **one big HAPPY FAMILY**...
loving one another with tender heart...

- Note 4: John 12:24
 - "Unless a grain of wheat is dropped into the ground and dies, it remains alone. But **if it dies, then it produces many grains**."
- Note 5: A lot of people don't like themselves. They don't feel good about themselves.
- Note 6: When we focus on ourselves, we don't feel good about ourselves. Self-esteem does not come from status. It comes from service.

 We were made to live for more than just ourselves!
- Note 7: Acts 20:24

...my life is worth nothing to me unless I use it for finishing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus—the work of **telling others the Good News** about the wonderful grace of God.

- Note 8: God wants to speak to the world through you (your life message).
- Note 9: SHARING YOUR LIFE MESSAGE (FAITH JOURNEY STORY)
 Your life message is a wonderful means of pointing others to a relationship with Jesus. It is a wonderful means of encouraging them in their own walk with Jesus (it REALLY encourages them who might be **hesitant or afraid** of turning over their life to Jesus. It may encourage them to follow your example.
- A. Start with: where you are from, where you live, what you do for a living, what connection you have in our church.
- B. How did you learn about Jesus? (How did you become a Christian?) Share about your life before you accepted Jesus (or before you became a Christian). If you were born into a Christian family, share about your life before you took God seriously.
- C. What event or feelings compelled you to take God seriously? At what point did you realize that Jesus was the primary focus of your life?
- D. Share **how your life has been made different because of God**. Share how God has blessed your life (Share the benefits and costs of following Jesus). Share what God is doing in your life today.
- Note 10: Luke 19:10
 - "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

Note 11: The lost people are those who have a misplaced relationship with God.

Note 12: TWO OUT OF THREE CHRISTIANS SAY THEY HAVE FOUND a relationship with God THROUGH A FRIEND (people, relationship).

Note 13: Luke 19:5 & 7

"Jesus stayed at Zacchaeus' house and ate with him."

Note 14: Begin to build a relationship with your friend by...

Note 15: **Everyone has a hunger for God at the deepest level**!
