Note 1:



Note 2: Ephesians 4:13-15

Note 3: Because we live with other **flawed people**, we are going to **experience** <u>hurt</u>. Because we live with other flawed people, we are also going to **experience** <u>the lack of guidance</u> that we want. Sometimes we don't have people available to guide us through our childhood. So, when we reach adulthood, we still have some really deep things going on inside of us. In some ways, we are driven to **fill some really deep needs**. But when we cannot function, we <u>choose addictive behavior</u> (false things) to fill those deep needs.

Note 4: Because we live with other flawed people, we are going to experience 1) hurt and 2) the lack of guidance. As a result, we may choose to shut down in that area, and just close ourselves off. In other words, we get stuck as a little child in that area. None of us are exempt from this. We are all going to get stuck somewhere at some point in our lives.

Note 5: I may get hurt by someone, and so I shut down my relationships. (I will not let anybody get close to me, not even God.) Or I may be disappointed, because I had goals for myself.

Note 7: Deuteronomy 7:21-24

Do not be terrified by them, for the LORD your God, who is among you, is a great and awesome God. The LORD your God will drive out those nations before you, little by little. You will not be allowed to eliminate them all at once, or the wild animals will multiply around you. But the LORD your God will deliver them over to you, throwing them into great confusion until they are destroyed. He will give their kings into your hand, and you will wipe out their names from under heaven. No one will be able to stand up against you; you will destroy them.

Note 8: You are going to have enemies. Those enemies will try to overpower you. But God will conquer your enemies. God is not going to conquer them all at once. God knew his children needed the learning process. So, **one by one, God would conquer** those enemies.

Note 9: We want to grow spiritually. But we need the learning process. Let us take one step at a time. If we allow God to do his work in our lives, we will grow spiritually!
