Note 2: Luke 18:27


"All things are possible with God."

"Jesus got into a boat, and his followers went with him. A great storm arose on the lake so that waves covered the boat...Then Jesus got up and gave a command to the wind and the waves, and it became completely calm."

Jesus had power over death.

Note 5: Matthew 28: 5-7

The angel said to the women, "...you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead..."

Note 6: Our God is a powerful God and our **God is an empowering God**. God wants to share God's strength with us.

Note 8: Where do we need God's strength the most?
